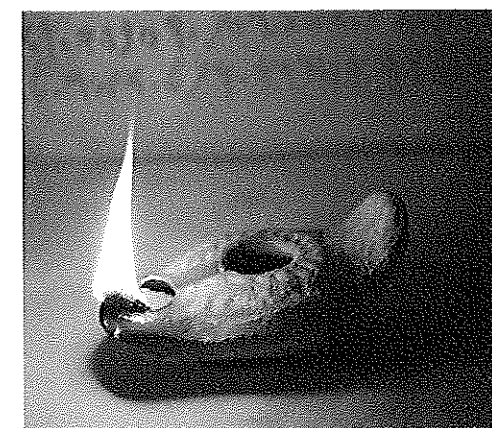
**Computer Classes** will be offered at 1:30 pm for *Power Point* on Monday, *Social Media* on Tuesday and *Excel* on Friday.

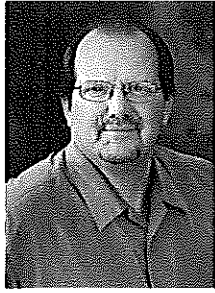
