## Track I - For Pastors, Associates & Spouses

### 1. *The Battle Against Pornography & Sexual Addiction in Your Church*

**Dr. Ted Roberts** is the former senior pastor of East Hill Church in Gresham, OR and the president and founder of Pure Desire Ministries. ### 2. *A Panel Discussion on the Manhattan Declaration*
